Procedure: Items to be delivered to venue by participant or delegate. Entry form, signed by participant and 2019 AB 55 plus membership card to be provided. Entry will be tagged and registered. Judging will occur on Jan. 19th. Upon completion of judging, 1st and 2nd place entries will be packaged and delivered to Provincial Competition by Zone representative. A maximum of 4 items from one individual can advance to the Provincial Competition.

An exhibition of all entries will occur from 1:00 pm until 3:30 pm. Entries not advancing to the Provincial Competition must be picked up by 4:00 pm.

Provincial medals will be given to the Zone representative and awarded at a Zone event.

55+ Membership: Everyone 55 years of age and over is eligible. 2019 Memberships will be available at registration - \$30.
